





Background: Current UK Context

- 359,115 graduates from an undergraduate degree in 2020–2021
- 39.4% of white graduates got a first-class degree, compared with 20.0% of black graduates
- Black students have highest non-continuation rates
- Non-continuation is higher at the intersection between minority ethnic groups and socio-economic disadvantage

Percentage of graduates within each ethnic group achieving the different degree classifications

Growing Capacity

IDEAS Program

A program of the U.S. Department of State Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs, USA Study Abroad branch

Seeking to broaden higher education institutions' capacity to grow study abroad programs for U.S. students

- Increase number of all students studying abroad, particularly those from historically underrepresented groups
- Increase the number of U.S. higher education institutions offering study abroad programs
- Expand study abroad to new overseas destinations, particularly those that are less common

Grant Competition

- Approximately 35 grants of up to \$35,000
- Approximately 1 consortium grant of up to \$50,000

Fulbright Specialist Program

The Fulbright Specialist Program provides short opportunities for **U.S. citizens who are well-established academics and professionals** to deepen collaboration with overseas institutions by serving as expert consultants and engaging in a range of education/training activities.

- 2-6 week-long projects comprised of education/training activities proposed by the overseas host institution
- ~400 projects annually in 150+ eligible countries
- Grant benefits are inclusive of international airfare and \$200 daily honorarium. Hosts traditionally provide lodging, meals, and in-country transportation.
- Administered by World Learning



Program Structure


- Host-driven structure: overseas institutions develop and submit project proposals. Host proposal deadlines and review timelines are determined on a country-by-country basis.
- U.S. individuals must apply for admission to the Fulbright Specialist Roster and be approved by peer review panel.
- If admitted, Roster candidates receive a **threeyear tenure** during which they may be matched with projects.
 - Submitting interest to an open project
 - Nomination by the host institution (named project)
