




Diagram: Agenda conflict (Davies, 2016)

regenerative leadership framework

- regenerative leadership includes influencing pro-environmental behaviors, including external stakeholders, planning for the long run
- regenerative leadership creates the conditions for sustainable and regenerative practices through a process of awareness and actions
 - > Personal mindset and behaviors
 - > Organizational mindset and behaviors
 - > Systems




Diagram: Regenerative Leadership model (Hardman, 2017)
