


Internationalization

Erasmus+ student mobilities | PT-EU | HED | IN and OUT | 1997-2022*




Erasmus+ Student & staff mobilities | PT-USA | 2015-2022

FLAD constitutes itself as a bridge between the two countries, a resource of excellence among those who seek and offer opportunities in the USA and Portugal.






Study in Portugal Network (SiPN)

In the last decade (08/09-18/19), Portugal had the biggest growth in the EU in terms of hosting US students, 341%.

- 8 years in operation
- 1500 students hosted
- SiPN accounted for 25-40% of all US students in Portugal**
